CERTIFICATE OF JUDGMENT

This cause having been duly submitted, IT IS CONSIDERED, ORDERED, AND ADJUDGED that the judgment of the Court of the Judiciary was that based on Judge Kaminski's resignation, he is guilty of violating Canons 1, 2, 2A, 2B, 2C, and 3C(1), as described in Counts One and Two of the Complaint. Count Three of the Complaint is dismissed, he agrees to never again seek judicial office in the state of Alabama, and both parties agree not to make any public statements that are contrary to the terms of the agreement, per entry of the Final Judgment on August 6, 2019.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Judge Kaminski is taxed with the costs of this proceeding allowed under Ala.R.Civ.P. 54 and the proceedings before the Judicial Inquiry Commission including the amount of \$2,346.67, to be paid within 90 days of entry of the Final Judgment. Judge Kaminski is also taxed with paying the costs for court reporter's services in the amount of \$143.00. All other costs are taxed as paid.
