
JOINT MOTION TO EXPEDITE


Come now the Judicial Inquiry Commission and Walker County District Judge Henry P. Allred and jointly move the Court for an order expediting the setting of the public hearing required by Article VI, §157 and expediting the resolution of the Complaint contemporaneously filed with this motion in this case.

As grounds for this motion, the Commission and Judge Allred show and represent to the Court that:

- a. pursuant to Article VI, §157, Judge Allred is disqualified from acting as a judge during the period of time that the Complaint filed herein remains pending and unresolved;
- b. the interest of the administration of justice would best be served by an expeditious resolution of this Complaint; and
- c. the spirit of the Rules of Procedure promulgated for the Court of the Judiciary by the Alabama Supreme Court favor the prompt, expeditious resolution of complaints, e.g., see Rule 7, Ala. R. P. Ct. of Judiciary, which favors “the prompt disposition of the proceedings pending before the court” and the avoidance of undue delay; and Rule 8, Ala. R. P. Ct. of Judiciary, which provides that “the court shall fix a date for hearing upon the complaint as expeditiously as possible.”
