Associate Judge - 1995-2001

Roger Miles Monroe, the son of Lane Rogers Monroe Buttram and the late Miles L. Monroe, graduated from Crossville High School in 1965, received his B.A. from the University of Alabama in 1969, and his J.D. from Cumberland School of Law in 1972.

Following graduation, Judge Monroe worked for the Alabama Attorney General's Office. He then engaged in the general practice of law in Birmingham for 18 years. In 1990, he ran for and was elected Circuit Judge, 10th Judicial Circuit. In 1994, he ran for and was elected Associate Judge, Court of Civil Appeals, and served one term in that position.

Judge Monroe has additionally served as Special Assistant Attorney General, and is a member of the Birmingham Bar Association, the Alabama State Bar Association, the Tennessee State Bar Association, the American Bar Association, and the American Judges Association.

Judge Monroe is married to the former Donna F. Weidman of Birmingham, and they are members of the Canterbury United Methodist Church of Birmingham.
