


Appellate Mediation Flow Chart



APPELLATE MEDIATION EVENT LINE

Notice of Appeal

7 days for Transmittal of Notice of Appeal and Docketing Statement

Docketing Statement Screened

Case Screening Form and Confidential Statement sent to parties. Notice to Stay Proceedings sent to trial clerk and (court reporter.) Court reporter to notify appellant of estimated costs of preparing the transcript.

14 days for parties to complete and return forms.

If parties agree, case is referred to mediation. If parties do not agree, Appellate Administrator decides whether case should be mediated. If case is inappropriate, will be reinstated on appellate docket. STAY IS LIFTED. ALL TIME REQUIREMENTS SHALL RESUME.

If parties mediate - Order of Referral to Mediation, Report on Status of Selection of Mediator and Appellate Mediation Roster issued.

14 days for parties to select mediator.

If parties agree on a mediator, a mediator is appointed. Order Appointing Mediator Pursuant Stipulation of the Parties issued. If parties do not agree on a mediator, the Appellate Administrator selects a mediator and issues Order Appointing Mediator Absent Stipulation of the Parties.

42 days for Mediation from Order Appointing Mediator Pursuant Stipulation of the Parties or Order Appointing Mediator Absent Stipulation of the Parties. (63 days from Order of Referral to Mediation)

Termination of Mediation

7 days for mediator to file Mediator's Report and (if applicable) Evaluations from attorneys and parties.

If partial or no agreement is reached, case is reinstated on appellate docket. STAY IS LIFTED. ALL TIME REQUIREMENTS SHALL RESUME. If agreement is reached, case dismissed on joint motion of the parties.
