In re: Number of Hard Copies of Documents Filed with the Supreme Court of Alabama

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

WHEREAS this Court having considered the number of hard copies of documents filed with the Supreme Court of Alabama,

IT IS ORDERED that, effective immediately, the Supreme Court of Alabama requires only two hard copies of documents filed pursuant to Rule 5, Rule 21, Rule 31, and Rule 40, Ala. R. App. P. If a document filed pursuant to those rules is e-filed pursuant to Rule 57, Ala. R. App. P., the filer must mail two hard copies of the e-filed document to the Supreme Court Clerk's Office within 24 hours of e-filing the document. If a document filed pursuant to those rules is filed in the traditional paper format, the filer should supply one additional hard copy of the document with the original copy of the paper document.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, effective immediately, the Supreme Court of Alabama no longer requires hard copies of documents filed pursuant to Rule 27 or Rule 39, Ala. R. App. P., if those documents are e-filed pursuant to Rule 57. If such documents are filed in the traditional paper format, only the original paper document is required.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, at the request of the Court, the Clerk of the Supreme Court of Alabama may direct the parties to file additional hard copies of any document filed in the Supreme Court of Alabama.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Order be spread upon the Minutes of the Supreme Court of Alabama.
