ORDER SETTING DISCLOSURE DATES

Not later than June 15, 2020, the parties shall exchange a list of exhibits the party may introduce at trial and a list of the witnesses who may be called by that party to testify at any time in the trial. Any objection of a party to the admissibility of any exhibit of the other party and any motions in limine must be filed not later than June 22, 2020. The parties may, by an agreement confirmed in writing (not verbal), modify the dates to disclose documents and witnesses and make objections so long as the trial date is not affected and any objections are to be made at least one week before trial. Unless manifest injustice would result, no party will be permitted (over objection) to call a witness or introduce an exhibit that is not on the list provided to the other party.
