ORDER

The parties are hereby directed to be prepared for a pretrial hearing at the conclusion of the oral arguments on the summary-judgment motions scheduled for August 8 at 1:30 p.m. While the Court will give full consideration to all issues raised in the summary-judgment motions, to avoid requiring the parties and counsel to reappear and the Court to reconvene on a later occasion, a pretrial hearing will be held at the conclusion of the oral arguments on August 8 in the event a hearing is required following the Court's disposition of the summary-judgment motions.


If a hearing is required following the Court's disposition of the summary-judgment motions, it is anticipated that this Court will convene that hearing on Wednesday, September 28, 2016, at 9 a.m.

At the pretrial hearing on August 8, the parties should be prepared to address the following matters:

1. How long each party anticipates a hearing would take in this matter;

2. Any objections and the bases for such objections the parties have to any exhibits to the various pleadings filed by the parties;
3. Any pretrial discovery matters that may need to be addressed;
4. Suggested discovery cut-off dates based upon the above-referenced hearing date of September 28, 2016; and
5. Such other pretrial issues that the parties anticipate or that may become apparent as a result of the oral arguments.
