CERTIFICATE OF JUDGMENT

This cause having been duly submitted, IT IS CONSIDERED, ORDERED, AND ADJUDGED that the judgment of the Court of the Judiciary was that Judge Kelly was suspended without pay for a period of 180 days and a Public Reprimand. Because Judge Kelly has been disqualified from serving, with pay, since August 16, 2017, she is to be reinstated to service on May 14, 2018. She shall serve without pay for 180 days from that date. On the 181st day following her reinstatement to service, she will be restored to full pay provided she, by the 151st day following her reinstatement to service, has certified to the Administrative Office of Courts that she is complying with this Court's order in good faith and intends to continue to do so, per entry of the Final Judgment on May 11, 2018.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Judge Kelly is taxed with the costs of publication of the public reprimand. All other costs are taxed as paid.
