**THE JUDICIAL INQUIRY COMMISSION'S MOTION TO EXTEND TIME FOR
FILING OF BRIEF IN OPPOSITION TO JUDGE KELLY'S MOTION TO
DISMISS**

COMES NOW the Judicial Inquiry Commission ("Commission") and respectfully requests this Court grant its motion to extend time for filing its brief in opposition to Judge Kelly's motion to dismiss by one day, to be due on October 18, 2017. In support of its request, the Commission shows the following:

1) This Court entered a scheduling order on September 25, 2017 in which Judge Kelly's brief in support of her motion to dismiss was to be due on October 10, 2017.

2) Judge Kelly did not submit her brief in support of her motion to dismiss until October 11, 2017.

3) On October 12, 2017, Judge Kelly filed a motion to extend time and allow out-of-time filing of her brief, which this Court granted. That same day, Judge Kelly filed the exhibits cited in her brief.

4) Per this Court's September 25, 2017 scheduling order, the Commission's response to Judge Kelly's motion to dismiss is due on October 17, 2017.


5) In its scheduling order, this Court granted the Commission 7 days to respond to Judge Kelly's motion to dismiss after she filed her brief in support.

6) Therefore, the Commission respectfully requests only a slight modification to this Court's scheduling order—that the Commission's response be due on October 18, 2017.

7) The undersigned has spoken to counsel for Judge Kelly, who is unopposed to this motion.

WHEREFORE, PREMISES CONSIDERED, the Commission requests that this motion be granted, and that this Court enter an order extending the Commission's deadline for filing a response to Judge Kelly's motion to dismiss to October 18, 2017.


