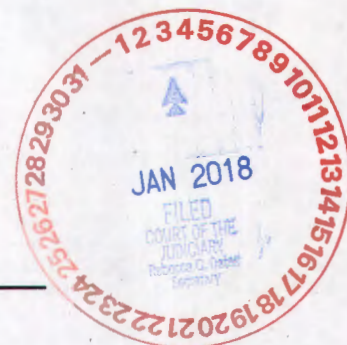


ORDER

This Court previously entered an order granting Judge Anita Kelly's December 4, 2017, motion for digital access. Judge Kelly filed a motion on December 28, 2017, to modify this Court's December 4, 2017, order "to include not only access for her counsel but also access for counsel's administrative staff." The Administrative Office of Courts ("AOC"), by letter filed with this Court, has stated that it has no objection to Judge Kelly's request "so long as the administrative staff member who is provided access is also subject to the Consent Protective Order agreed to by the parties in this matter and entered by the Court of the Judiciary on November 28, 2017."

In light of Judge Kelly's motion and the response of AOC, this Court's December 4, 2017, order is **MODIFIED** to include the administrative staff of Judge Kelly's counsel, which staff shall also be subject to the requirements of this

Court's consent protective order of November 28, 2017. AOC may require the administrative staff personnel to sign a document indicating that they have agreed to comply with this Court's consent protective order. Furthermore, regardless of whether Judge Kelly's counsel is present with the administrative staff when digital access is obtained, counsel shall ensure that the administrative staff complies with this Court's November 28, 2017, protective order as well as any other professional obligations applicable to counsel. See Rule 5.3, Ala. R. Prof'l Conduct.
