STATUS ORDER

Efforts continue to be made to schedule the trial of this case. Scheduling is dependent upon numerous factors including logistics such as the limited times that courtroom space can be made available to the Court of the Judiciary by the Supreme Court. A major factor in scheduling is estimating how many days of trial are required so that other pre-existing obligations can be rescheduled accordingly. It is noted that the parties have exchanged witness lists, and those lists contain 22 potential witnesses. After making diligent efforts, there are no dates in December that would permit a trial of that length to occur.

The following order is entered: Not later than December 6, 2019, the parties shall exchange a list of potential exhibits the party intends to introduce at trial. Any objection of a party to the admissibility of any exhibit of the other party and any motions in limine must be filed not later than December 20, 2019. Unless manifest injustice would result, no party will be permitted (over objection) to call a witness or introduce an exhibit that is not on the list provided to the other party.
