**ORDER CONTINUING TRIAL AND
ADRESSING STATUS OF OTHER MATTERS**

In view of Administrative Order No. 6 of the Supreme Court of Alabama pertaining to the Covid-19 Pandemic, which ordered that no juror summons would be issued before July 1, 2020 and did not establish a date when jury trials can be resumed, it is **ORDERED** by the Court as follows:

1. The scheduled June 15, 2020 trial of this case is continued generally and will be reset after the issuance of further orders by the Supreme Court of Alabama.
2. A hearing on the Defendant's Motion to Dismiss All Counts of Indictment will be set by a subsequent order to be issued after May 18, 2020.
3. The May 21, 2020 deadline for filing Motions *in limine* is extended and will be reset by a subsequent order of the Court.
4. All other deadlines set and provisions in the prior Order that was entered on February 12, 2020 shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect.
