ORDER

The Court has considered Judge Jinks's Motion for Extension of Time and the Judicial Inquiry Commission's Response to Judge Jinks's Motion for Disclosure of Witnesses and for Extension of Time. Judge Jinks's Motion for Extension of Time is granted. The August 16, 2021, trial setting is cancelled.

- 3.) Exchange copies of potential exhibits by August 28, 2021. The exhibits exchanged before trial are not required to include items used exclusively for rebuttal or impeachment purposes.
- 4.) Discovery shall be complete by August 28, 2021.

Amendments to this scheduling order to be granted only upon a showing of good cause.

This case is set for a status conference and a hearing to consider any pending motions on July 30, 2021, at 11:00 a.m. in the courtroom of the Alabama Court of Criminal Appeals, second floor, Alabama Judicial Building, Montgomery, Alabama.

This case is set for trial on September 29, 2021, at 10:00 a.m. in the courtroom of the Alabama Supreme Court, third floor, Alabama Judicial Building, 300 Dexter Avenue, Montgomery, Alabama.
