ORDER


A status conference was held on August 30, 2021. Judge Jinks appeared with his attorney, Amanda Hardy. Elizabeth Bern, Jenny Garrett, and John Selden appeared on behalf of the Judicial Inquiry Commission.

The attorneys agree that there are no pending motions that need to be resolved by the Court. Judge Jinks has filed Interrogatories and a Request for Production which need to be answered. Any objections to the Interrogatories and/or the Request for Production shall be filed by Tuesday, September 7, 2021. Responses to the Interrogatories and the Request for Production are due on or before September 13, 2021.

Attorneys for both parties have requested an opportunity to file a trial brief with the court. This request is granted. Trial briefs shall be filed on or before September 22, 2021. After receipt of the trial briefs, the undersigned will determine whether all nine members of the Court of the Judiciary will be allowed to consider the trial briefs. Any objections to the trial briefs being submitted to the entire court can be filed in a separate motion. Said motion will be placed under seal after review by the undersigned judge. Any proposed exhibits that are submitted to the Court prior to trial will not be provided to the entire Court of the Judiciary prior to the exhibit's admission into evidence unless otherwise agreed upon by both parties.

During the trial of this case, the attorneys will be given 10 minutes to present an opening statement. Rebuttal witnesses will be allowed.
