

**ORDER**

A hearing was held before all nine members of the Court of the Judiciary on May 14, 2021. Judge Price appeared with his attorney, Tommy Nail. Elizabeth Bern appeared on behalf of the Judicial Inquiry Commission. Both attorneys were given an opportunity to present an argument on behalf of the proposed settlement that was filed with the court pursuant to Rule 16, Rules of Procedure for the Alabama Court of the Judiciary. The proceedings were then in recess for the members of the Court of the Judiciary to consider the proposed resolution of this matter. After full consideration of all information presented, six or more members of the Court did not agree that the proposed resolution should be accepted. Therefore, pursuant to Rule 16, Rules of Procedure for the Alabama Court of the Judiciary, a final adjudication has not been reached and further proceedings will be required.

As mandated by Rule 16, “[n]either the fact of the [aforementioned] filing nor any fact alleged therein or related thereto” will be considered by the Court in future proceedings related to this matter.
