ORDER

Judge Blocton has filed a subpoena duces tecum, requesting the production of certain documents by the Administrative Office of Courts (hereinafter referred to as the "AOC"), and scheduled a deposition for October 5, 2021. Objections having been filed, the deposition will not be held on October 5, 2021.

The AOC shall produce all relevant, non-privileged, non-objectionable documents on or before October 7, 2021. Parties are to attempt to resolve the disagreement regarding production of additional documents on or before October 12, 2021.


The AOC's Objection to Subpoena is set for a hearing on October 14, 2021 at 9:00 a.m. in the courtroom of the Court of Criminal Appeals, Heflin-Torbert Judicial Building, 300 Dexter Avenue, Montgomery, Alabama. This hearing will be cancelled if the parties have resolved the discovery dispute and if they have notified the Court (on or before October 12, 2021) that the hearing will no longer be necessary.
