ORDER

The Judicial Inquiry Commission has notified the court that it does not oppose Judge Self's Motion to Stay. After consideration of Judge Self's Motion to Stay, the Commission's response thereto, and authorities related to the issues raised in Judge Self's motion, the Motion to Stay is GRANTED.

This matter will be reviewed periodically by the undersigned judge. Pursuant to Rule 7, Rules of Procedure for the Alabama Court of the Judiciary, unnecessary delays in Judge Self's criminal case pending in Lauderdale County will not be grounds for an extension of this stay.

The Commission and Judge Self are granted leave to request, at any time, that this stay be lifted. If the charges pending against Judge Self in Lauderdale County are resolved or if a trial date is set in Judge Self's criminal case, the Commission shall, within 7 days, file a written notice in this court regarding the disposition or the trial date.
