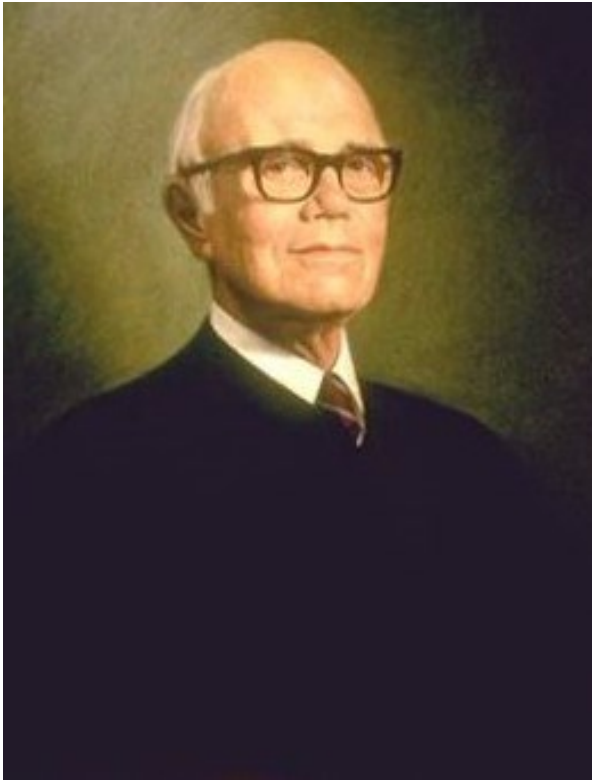


DANIEL THOMAS MCCALL, JR.

A native of Choctaw County, Alabama, Daniel Thomas McCall, Jr. was the son of Dr. Daniel T. McCall and Caroline Winton Bush McCall. The family moved to Mobile, Alabama when he was a child. He attended public schools and the University Military School in Mobile, where he graduated in 1927. McCall, Jr. earned a A.B. degree from the University of Alabama in 1931, and a LL.B. degree in 1933.

McCall practiced law until 1960, with the exception of his military service in World War II. From 1943-1960, McCall, Jr. was a partner in the firm Johnston, McCall, and Johnston. In 1960, he was elected a Circuit Judge for Mobile County. He was re-elected in 1964, and remained in this position until October 1969, when Governor Albert P. Brewer appointed him to the Supreme Court of Alabama as an associate justice. He remained on the Court until his retirement in 1975.

McCall, Jr. married Mary Edna Montgomery on April 03, 1937 and they had three children.
