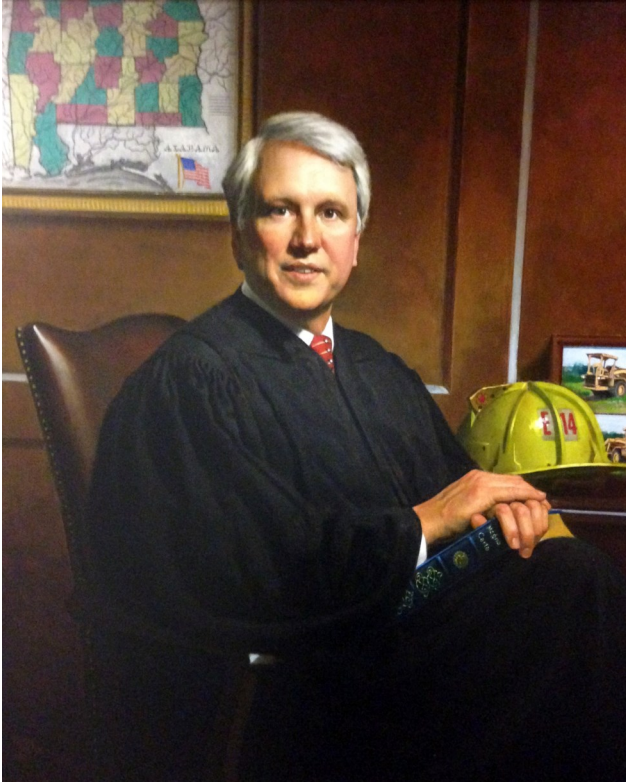


HAROLD FREND SEE, JR.

A native of Chicago, Illinois, Harold Frend See, Jr., received a Bachelor of Arts degree from Emporia State University, Kansas; a Master of Science degree in economics from Iowa State University; and a Juris Doctorate degree from the University of Iowa College of Law.

See served as Assistant Professor of Economics at Illinois State University, and was in the private practice of law prior to joining the faculty of the University of Alabama School of Law, where he served for over twenty years as Associate Professor, Full Professor, and as the Herbert D. Warner Professor of Law.

He is a contributing editor to the Federal Circuit Bar Journal. He is a member of many associations and institutions. He also served as reporter for the American Trade Secrets acts and suggested revisions to Alabama's arbitration law. See was elected to the Supreme Court of Alabama as an Associate Justice in 1996.
