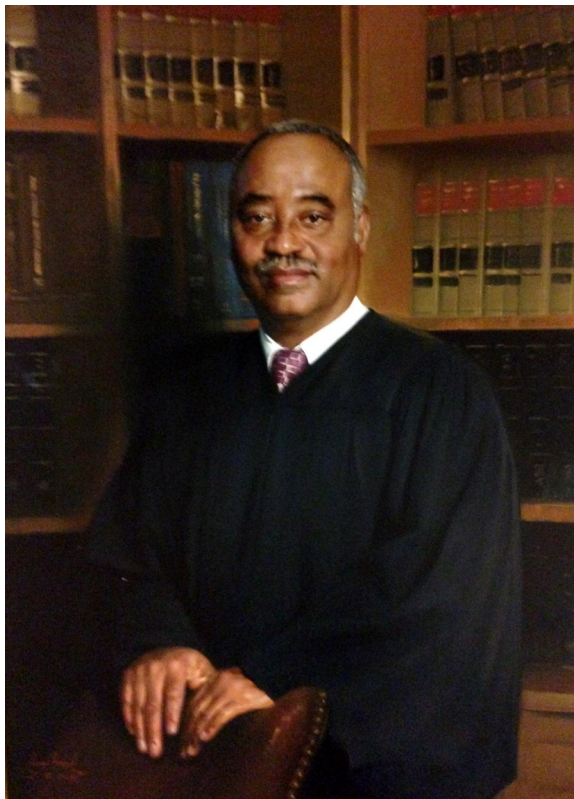


JOHN HENRY ENGLAND, JR.

Associate Justice: 1999-2001

A native of Uniontown, Alabama, John Henry England, Jr. graduated from Tuskegee Institute in 1969. He served as a Military Policeman in the United States Army from 1970 to 1972. He graduated from the University of Alabama School of Law in 1974. He was admitted to the Alabama State Bar on November 21, 1974.

England was elected to the Tuscaloosa City Council in 1985, where he served two terms. He practiced law in Tuscaloosa, Alabama until 1993.

He continued in private practice until he was appointed to the Sixth Circuit in Tuscaloosa, serving as a circuit judge from 1993-1999. From 1998 to 1999, he served as Presiding Circuit Judge of the Sixth Judicial Circuit

England was appointed to serve on the Supreme Court of Alabama as an Associate Justice in 1999, serving from September 1999 to January 2001.

England is the father of three children: John H. England, III, April England Albright, and Christopher J. England.
