A native of Enterprise, Alabama, Glenn Murdock received a B.A. degree in Political Science and Economics from the University of Alabama in 1978. He received a Juris Doctorate degree from the University of Virginia Law School in 1981. Also, he was admitted to the Alabama State Bar in 1981.

Upon relocating to Birmingham, Alabama, in 1981, Murdock served for a year as law clerk to Clarence W. Alford in the United States Northern District of Alabama in 1981-1982. He practiced law in Birmingham, Alabama from 1982-2000. He served as an Administrative Law Judge from 1999-2000. He is a member of the Birmingham Bar Association.

Murdock ran unsuccessfully for Alabama Supreme Court in 1998. In 2000, Murdock was elected to serve as a judge on the Alabama Court of Civil Appeals. In 2006, he was elected to the Supreme Court of Alabama as an associate justice, and re-elected in 2012, serving until his resignation effective January 16, 2018.

Murdock married Margaret Gilchrist, and they have three children.
