A native of Troy, Alabama, James Allen Main, received a B. S. in pharmacy from Auburn University, and a juris doctorate degree from the University of Alabama. He was admitted to the Alabama State Bar in 1972, and began a law practice in Anniston, Alabama. He served as Anniston City Attorney, Lineville City Judge, and City Attorney for Oxford, Alabama. He began a law practice in Montgomery, Alabama in 1989.

Main served as Chief of Staff and Legal Advisor to Governor Fob James. He served as Director of Finance during Governor Bob Riley's administration. He was appointed by Governor Riley as a Judge on the Court of Criminal Appeals from 2009-2011. Then he was appointed to the Supreme Court of Alabama as an associate justice on January 14, 2011. He retired in January 2019.

He is a member of the Alabama Bar Association; past president of the American Pharmacists Association; past chairman of the Dean's Counsel for the Auburn School of Pharmacy, and a past member of the Alabama Commission on Higher Education.
