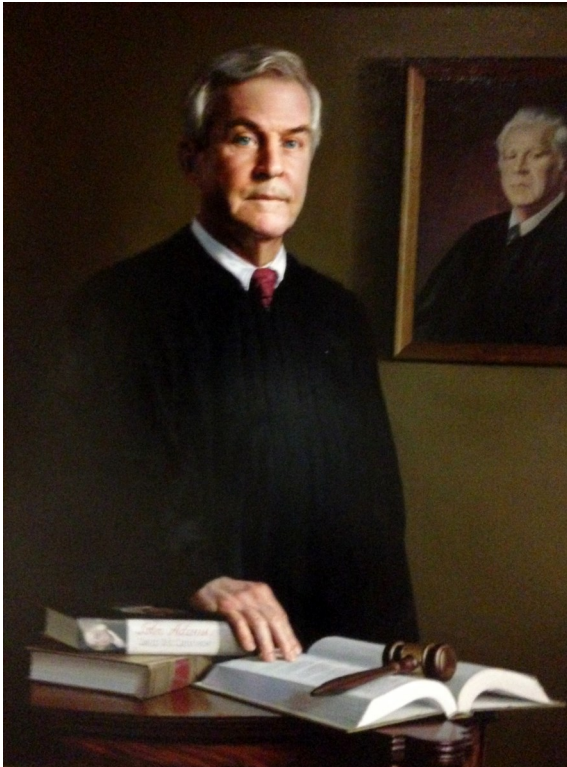


ROBERT BERNARD HARWOOD, JR.

Associate Justice: 2001-2007

A native of Montgomery, Alabama, Robert Bernard Harwood, Jr., graduated from the South-Sewanee in 1959. He graduated from the University of Alabama in 1962, and the University of Alabama School of Law in 1963.

From 1969-1975, Harwood served as Special Assistant Attorney General for the State of Alabama. From 1975 to 1980, he served as Deputy municipal Judge for the city of Tuscaloosa, appointed circuit judge in 1991, and elected as Circuit Judge in 1992. He was re-elected in 1998.

He is a member of the Tuscaloosa County Bar Association, and served as President from 1978 - 1979. He was the Farrah Law President in 1980 and 1981. He is a member of the Alabama and American Bar Associations, and the Tuscaloosa Inns of Court, where he served as President in 1991 and 1992.

Harwood was elected to the Supreme Court of Alabama as an associate justice in 2000. He retired from the Court in 2007, and rejoined the firm that is currently known as Rosen Harwood as a founding partner, located in Tuscaloosa, Alabama.

Justice Harwood and his wife Kathryn have three children.
