ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that Rule 20(A), Alabama Rules of Judicial Administration, be amended to modify, under the category of "General Offenses," the fine amount for the offense of "Failure to move over or reduce speed when approaching enforcement or emergency vehicles" from \$100 to \$200;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Rule 20B(f), Alabama Rules of Judicial Administration, be amended to remove the offense of "33-6A-6 Failure to have marine-sanitation-device inspection decal," along with the corresponding fine of \$75;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that these amendments are effective October 1, 2024; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the following note from the reporter of decisions be added to follow Rule 20 and Rule 20B:

"Note from the reporter of decisions: The order amending Rule 20(A) and Rule 20B(f), effective October 1, 2024, is published in that volume of *Alabama Reporter* that contains Alabama cases from __ So. 3d."
