ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that Rule 20(A), Alabama Rules of Judicial Administration, "Schedule of Fines for Traffic Offenses," be amended to increase the fine associated with the offense of "Failure to move over or reduce speed when approaching enforcement or emergency vehicles" from \$25 to \$100;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Appendix B to Rule 20, Alabama Rules of Judicial Administration, "Supreme Court's Extended Schedule of Fines," be amended to add to the section "Conservation - Lands" Regulation No. "220-4-.15(t)" with its fine following Regulation No. 220-4-.15(s), as shown in the Appendix to this order;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Appendix B to Rule 20, Alabama Rules of Judicial Administration, "Supreme Court's Extended Schedule of Fines," be amended to remove the offense of "Criminal littering," including the Code reference (§ 13A-7-29(a)(4)) and the fine, from the "Title 13A Offenses" section;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that these amendments are effective immediately; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the following note from the reporter of decisions be added to the follow Rule 20 and Appendix B to Rule 20:

"Note from the reporter of decisions: The order amending Rule 20(A) and Appendix B to Rule 20, effective January 30, 2020, is published in that volume of Alabama Reporter that contains Alabama cases from ___ So. 3d."
