Rule 34(f), Ala. R. App. P.

(f) Counsel Who May Present Argument and Sit at Counsel Tables. Counsel may present argument on behalf of a party only if the counsel is listed on the party's brief or files a notice of appearance with the court. Without leave of court, only counsel who are permitted to present argument may sit at the counsel tables.
